Dear Parents and Staff,

A few days ago the federal government announced it will end the Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA) program, and I join State Superintendent of Instruction Tom Torlakson in denouncing the decision to end this program that provided support to so many students and families, including those in our own community. Along with Superintendent Torlakson and many others, I urge Congress to act swiftly to provide a path to citizenship for students who were brought to our country as young children and who have spent most of their lives in the United States.

I want all families in our community who are affected by this law to understand that we support you and stand behind you. Our school Board passed a resolution on January 19, 2017, specifically stating our support for all students regardless of their immigration status. Among other things, the resolution promised that we will not collect information regarding students' immigration status and that we will take all legally permissible actions to protect the privacy rights of our students and their families.
