Education Code 49406 -- Examination for Tuberculosis

Education Code 49406 States in part:

No person shall be initially employed by a school district unless the person has submitted to an examination within the past 60 days to determine that he or she is free of active tuberculosis. This examination shall consist of an approved intradermal tuberculin test, which, if positive, shall be followed by an X-ray of the lungs.

A person who transfers his or her employment from one school or school district to another shall be deemed to meet the requirements in the above first paragraph if that person can produce evidence which shows that he or she was examined within the past four years and was found to be free of communicable tuberculosis.

Thereafter, employees who are skin test negative shall be required to undergo the foregoing examination at least once each four years for so long as the employee remains skin test negative. Once an employee has documented positive skin test which has been followed by an X-ray, the foregoing examination is no longer required and a referral shall be made within 30 days of completion of the examination to the local health officer to determine the need for follow-up care.

After the examination, each employee shall cause to be on file a certificate from the examining physician and surgeon showing the employee was examined and found free from active tuberculosis.

This examination is a condition of initial employment.
