The Cabrillo Unified School District is pleased to announce the selection of a finalist for the position of Assistant Principal of Hatch Elementary School. The Cabrillo Unified School District Governing Board will be asked to approve the recommendation to appoint Ms. Amy McVicker for this position. Currently, McVicker teaches Language Arts at Cunha Intermediate School in the Cabrillo Unified School District. She is also the Common Core specialist for Language Arts at the school. Prior to serving in Cabrillo, Ms. McVicker served as a middle school Language Arts teacher and Intervention Services provider in Oxnard, California. She has also been a middle school Spanish teacher in Highlands Ranch, Colorado.

Ms. McVicker earned her Bachelor of Arts Degree in both English and Spanish with a minor in Education from the University of Denver and has a Masters degree in Educational Leadership from California Lutheran University. Ms. McVicker has more than twelve years of experience as both a teacher and teacher leader.

In the selection process, a diverse group of, teachers, classified staff, and administrators chose a slate of six candidates to interview. The committee selected two finalists for the district administrative team to interview and determine the best candidate. Besides oral interviews, an extensive review of past employment histories for all candidates was performed.
