STUDENT EMERGENCY SUPPLY LIST**

Dear Parents:

In the event of a disaster such as a major earthquake, it is likely that many students will spend an extended amount of time at school waiting for a parent or a responsible adult listed on their disaster/emergency form to pick them up. Many of our students' parents work outside of the immediate area and may experience difficulty and delays in returning to school.

Basic emergency supplies are already stored at school. The staff at Kings Mountain School request additional supplies to be labeled and stored in the classrooms for each of the students. Parents are being asked to provide a number of items to better care for their child(ren) during a 24-72 hour period following a major disaster.

Please place the following items inside the Ziploc bag labeled with your child's name and bring to your child's classroom:

- Emergency Contact and Release Form (filled out)
- 2 small, sealed bottles of water (8-12 oz.)
- 2 protein/power bars
- 1 small package moist towelettes

**Also recommended:**

- A reassuring note from parents
- A family picture
- A small working flashlight

Please remind the people on your Emergency Contact and Release Form that they are authorized to pick up your child(ren) in an emergency. These Emergency supplies will be returned to each family at the end of the school year. It is suggested that all families participate in this preparedness program. If there is a family hardship that prevents your participation, please contact me.
