- Measure S bonds sale \$23k, still holding Measure M.
- F.V. Estimate \$23,409,000, E.G Estimate \$45,974,000, Other \$7,961,782
- Comp actual cost for Hatch: \$39,501,000
- Roger (construction mgr.) explains the lease/lease back concept for the upcoming projects.
- 6 companies applied for the FV job, hired Core Construction.
