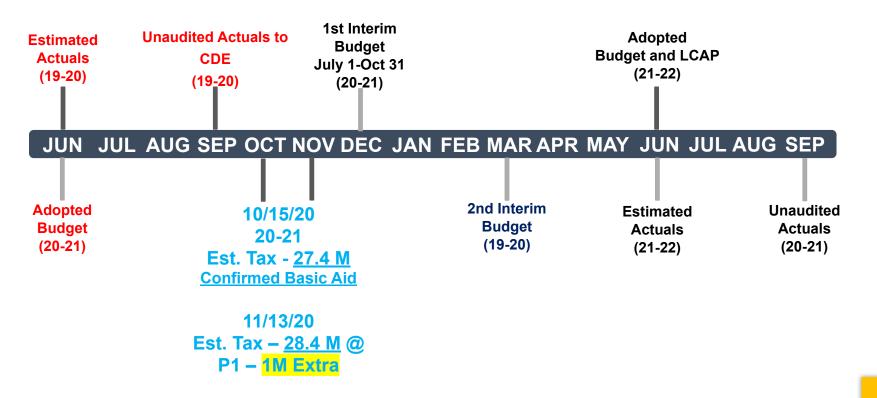

Federal law requires districts required to provide a comprehensive Individualized Education Program (IEP): *Free and Appropriate Public Education* (FAPE) – 34 CFR Section 300.320

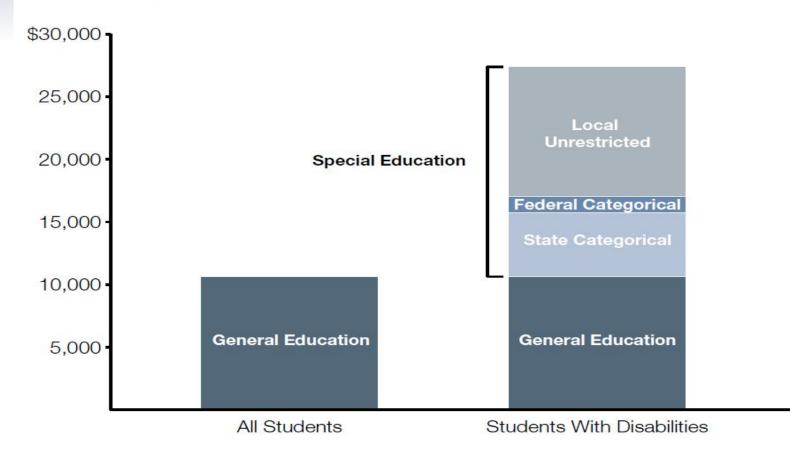

Special Education Funding (Cont.)

District unrestricted funds cover the majority of Special Education expenditures:

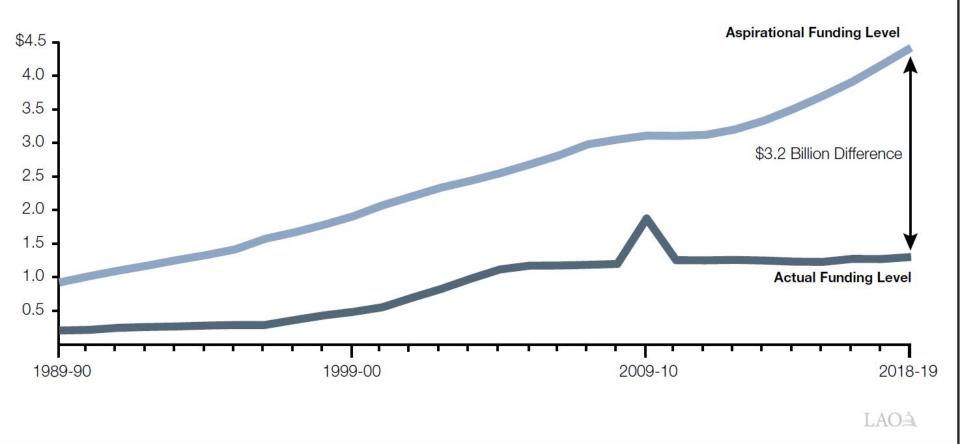
- District unrestricted 61%
- State of California funding 28%
- Federal funding 11%

Federal government is required to cover 40% of the states' special education cost.



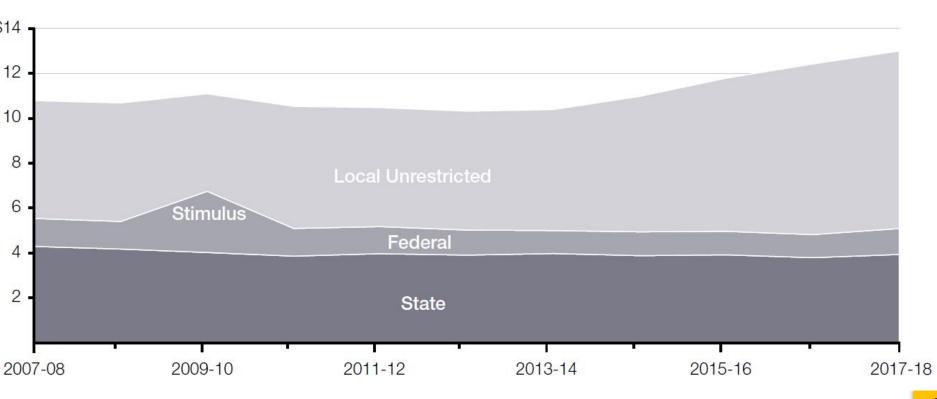
Federal Special Education Funding Falls Short of Aspirational Target
